

HOMECOMING COURT SELECTION PROCESS

1. All applications are due with the non-refundable \$10 application fee by **3:00 p.m.** on Thursday, October 15, 2009 and will be screened for completeness by the Director of Student Activities and the Homecoming Committee Chair.

Note: All applicants must have and maintain a minimum 2.75 G.P.A.

2. The Homecoming Selection Committee will consist of the Homecoming Committee chair, members of the ASB Executive Board, Junior Class and Student Activities Adult Staff. Selections will be made on the basis of the information provided in the application and the personal interview.
3. The personal interviews will take place on Wednesday, October 21, 2009 in the Student Activities office. The committee will then select a maximum of five finalists from the pool of completed applications.
4. Candidate interviews may possibly be videotaped as additional promotion of the court selections.
5. Candidate speeches will be recorded on videotape on Friday, October 23 beginning at 3:15. Candidates should report no later than the scheduled time to the administration building **in their school uniforms**.
6. Speeches should be no longer than 1 minute in length. A printed copy must be submitted with the application for approval. Speeches will be aired on Thursday, October 29, 2009 during second period. Voting will take place immediately following the broadcast.
7. All members of the Homecoming Court are required to be present at the Homecoming Rally on Friday, October 30, 2009 and should report to the gymnasium in jeans and black/gold no later than 10:45 a.m.
8. All members of the Homecoming Court (with their escorts) are required to be in formal attire for the Football game and crowning on Saturday, October 31, 2009 (before 1:00 p.m.). Their attire should be classy, **not revealing**. Any candidates not dressed appropriately will be immediately disqualified. Escorts for the Homecoming game and crowning are to be the father, brother, or another male relative of the candidate.
9. In addition to the application, the following criteria will be considered throughout the interview:
 - A. **Professional Appearance (20%)**
 - B. **Personality (30%)**
 - C. **Poise - ease and dignity of manner (10%)**
 - D. **Sincerity in responses (15%)**
 - E. **Quality of Responses (25%)**
